Week 1	Eternal King (God) Psalm 93:1,2 John 1:1-3	<i>God's kingdom is eternal.</i>	"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made." John 1:1-3	Worship I worship My Eternal God	Drive Time: Ask your child what it means that God is "eternal and external" This year your child is bringing a GodTime handout home each week to develop a personal time with God.
Week 2	Mutiny (Lucifer: Satan-Rebellious Heart)	<i>God opposes the rebellious heart while He favors the obedient heart</i>		Trust I trust and obey God	Drive Time: Ask your child about what they have learned about Satan. Talk about why God hates the rebellious heart. Review John 1:1-3 with your child
Week 3	Just One Bite (Adam & Eve) Genesis 1-3	<i>I choose to obey God</i>	"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9	Trust I can trust God no matter what	Drive Time: Ask about the 4 A's : God's way to deal with sins in their lives: Acknowledge your responsibility/Ask forgiveness/Make Amends /Turn Away.
Week 4	Undivided Heart (Cain & Abel) Genesis 4	<i>God wants to own my heart, so I must keep my heart closed to sin</i>		Trust & Wisdom I can trust and follow God's way	Bed Time: Pray with your child to have an undivided heart. Pray for your child to have a heart pure and devoted to God
Week 5	I Promise (Abraham) Genesis 12-25	<i>God keeps His promises no matter what</i>	"For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through Him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. 2 Corinthians 1:20	Trust I can trust God no matter what	Refrigerator Note: Make a poster of 2 Corinthians 1:20 to remind each other God is faithful and trustworthy.
Week 6	Good and Bad (Joseph) Genesis 37-50	<i>God keeps His promises no matter what</i>		Trust I can trust God no matter what	Bed Time: Read Romans 8:28 together and talk about how God can use both good and bad times for His purpose as He did in the life of Joseph.
Week 7	Good Bye to False gods (10 Plagues) Exodus 1-18	<i>God should be my #1</i>		Worship I worship God only	Mealttime: Ask your child to share how the 10 plagues related to the Egyptians gods in Exodus. Talk about how we should make God #1 in our lives
Week 8	Holy People (Moses and the People) Exodus 19-Lev. 27	<i>God gave His rules to help me to be holy.</i>	"But just as He who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do." 1 Peter 1:15	Wisdom I need to make wise choices by following God	Bed Time: The GodTime page your child brought from Sunday goes along with their Sunday School lessons. Use this week's Godtime for Bed Time talk.
Week 9	Trust Me (Moses and the People)	<i>God wants me to trust Him, because He promises to supply all our needs</i>	Hebrews 11:6	Trust I trust God no matter what	Mealttime: Talk about how the Israelites failed to trust God, whining and complaining. Challenge your family to monitor their attitude this week!



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Week 10	Victory (Joshua)	<i>Victory comes from trusting and obeying God no matter what!</i>	Joshua 1: 7	Trust I trust and follow God no matter what	Drive Time: Ask your child to share about how Joshua led the Israelites to victory; a key battle strategy and talk about how they can apply "Trusting" God to win their battles.
Week 11	Re-Cycled! (Judges)	<i>God will restore us if we ask Him as we sin</i>		Worship I worship God with my life	Bed Time: Ask your child to share "The Judge Cycle" and pray together not to repeat the same mistakes over and over again.
Week 12	Obedience Training (Gideon)	<i>I must obey God rather than men!</i>	Review Memory Verses (John 1:1-3, 1John 1:9, 2 Corinthians 1:20, 1 Peter 1:15-16, Hebrew 11:6, Joshua 1:7)	Trust and Wisdom I trust and obey God	Meal Time: Ask your child about what Big doG stands for (Disciple of God) and talk about what it means to have God as our master.
Week 13	God's Story Rewind (Review and Celebrate)				Bed Time: Ask your child to share what they have learned about God over the past two months.
Week 14	United We Stand (Saul and David)	<i>God looks at my heart</i>	Psalm 51:10-11	Trust and Wisdom I choose to follow God wholeheartedly	Bed Time: Teach your child to pray using Psalm 51:10-11, asking God to create a pure heart and renew a steadfast spirit within them.
Week 15	Living Wisely (Solomon)	<i>To fear God and follow His instruction is living wisely</i>	Proverbs 1:7	Trust and Wisdom I trust and obey God	Meal Time: Read Proverbs 1:7 before dinner and talk about how each of your family can life wisely by following God's instruction written in the Bible.
Week 16	Welcome To Our World (Isaiah/Micah/Jesus)	<i>God's promise is fulfilled by the birth of Jesus</i>	Isaiah 9:6	Worship I worship Jesus	Family Project: Make an invitation card to invite another family to Carmel's Christmas Eve service sharing the Christmas story and go on caroling in your street!
