Hebrews 12:5-6</b>	<b>Wisdom</b> I need to make wise choices by following God's way	<b>Mealtime:</b> Ask your child to share the events that led to the division of the kingdom and civil war among God's people and talk about the importance of making wise choices by following God's way.
Week 2	<b>Shape Up</b> <i>Elijah</i>	<i>God wants His disobedient people to repent and to seek Him.</i>		<b>Worship</b> I worship God with my life	<b>Bed Time:</b> Read 1 Kings 17-19 together and talk about how God showed Himself to be the one and only true God. Ask what the name Elijah means.
Week 3	<b>Expelled</b> <i>Jeremiah</i>	<i>God disciplines His people when they refuse to trust Him</i>	<b>"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. I will be found by you," declares the Lord, "and will bring you back from captivity." Jeremiah 29:11-14</b>	<b>Wisdom &amp; Worship</b> I follow and worship God	<b>Drive Time:</b> Ask your child to share what they learned about the prophet Jeremiah. <b>Meal Time:</b> Read Philippians 2:4-8 together and talk about how we can win the heart of others with an attitude of humility and love like Jesus demonstrated for us.
Week 4	<b>Rebuilders</b> <i>Ezra</i>	<i>God responds to prayer and obedience of His children and I can be a Big doG (Disciple of God)</i>		<b>Wisdom &amp; Worship</b> I follow and worship God.	<b>Bed Time:</b> Ask your child about how Ezra led the Israelites from Babylon back to Jerusalem. Talk about how God responds to the humbling of His people. Read Jeremiah 29:11 and thank God for His perfect plan for us.
Week 5	<b>Rescue</b> <i>Esther</i>	<i>God protects His people from disaster, and I can be a Big doG by taking a stand for God</i>	<b>"And if I perish, I perish." Esther 4:16</b>	<b>Trust &amp; Wisdom</b> I trust God and need to make wise choices by following God's way	<b>Meal Time:</b> Talk about how they can take a stand for God.
Week 6	<b>Big doG</b> <i>Nehemiah</i>	<i>God looks at the heart, so my attitude counts.</i>	<b>"Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves." Philippians 2:3</b>	<b>Wisdom &amp; Worship</b> I follow and worship God	<b>Drive Time:</b> Ask your child to share what she/he learned about Nehemiah and talk about how attitude counts.
