



A CALL TO PRAYER: March 10 – May 5

Praying scripture is a powerful and beautiful spiritual discipline. And praying the same verses together as a church body builds up our faith and unity. As we study Galatians together, let's commit to daily reflect on His word and commit our hearts to live out the gift of salvation given to us through Christ. *Holy Spirit, work in our hearts and minds.*

SUNDAYS - To Have Eyes to See Father, give us wisdom to understand what the Gospel is and discernment to recognize 'false gospels' when we see them. (Galatians 1:3-7; Mark 1:15; Romans 1:16; Ephesians. 1:13-14)

MONDAYS - To Walk Consistently in Grace Father, help us to walk with wholeness and not hypocrisy. May we live our lives knowing that we are "justified by faith and not by works of the law." (Galatians 2:16; Romans 5:1; Romans 10:9-10)

TUESDAYS - To Live Every Day by Faith Father, may we understand today that "the righteous live by faith." May we understand that was true at our conversion to Christ and is also true every day for the rest of our lives. Protect us from the deceit of sliding back into a "works based salvation." (Galatians 3:10-13; Romans 1:16-17; Ephesians 2:8-9)

WEDNESDAYS - To Love Well Father, may we use our freedom in Christ not to indulge our flesh but rather to love one another really well. Would You show us today how to practically demonstrate the love of Christ to someone we will encounter? (Galatians 5:13-15; I Peter 1:22-23; I John 4:7-8; John 13:34-35)

THURSDAYS - To Fulfill Our Purpose Father, we choose this day to live by the Spirit and not the flesh. May the presence of Your Holy Spirit in us bear much fruit in our lives, so that You would be glorified through it and others would be ministered to by it. (Galatians 5:16-24; Romans 8:13-14; John 15:4-5; John 15:8)

FRIDAYS - To Carry One Another's Burdens Father, would You give us hearts of compassion and the desire to be gentle with those around us who are struggling. We choose this day to bear one another's burdens. (Galatians 6:1-5; Matthew 11:28-30; Philippians 4:13-14; Proverbs 17:17)

SATURDAYS - To Live with Open Hands Father, would You unleash in us a culture of generosity. Would You open our eyes to see the principle of sowing and reaping? May we sow in the Spirit and not sow in the flesh. (Galatians 6:6-10; 2 Cor. 9:6; 1 Thess. 5:15; Hebrews 13:16)

CHAPTER 1

Galatians 1:10

For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ.

CHAPTER 2

Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

CHAPTER 3

Galatians 3:3

After beginning with the Spirit, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort?

CHAPTER 4

Galatians 4:7

So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

CHAPTER 5

Galatians 5:13

For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

CHAPTER 6

Galatians 6:2

Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.
