Prepare Yourself:

- Determine whom the Lord is placing on your heart to reach out to.
- 2. Pray for Open Doors.
- 3. Look for Divine Appointments Daily.
- 4. Make the most of every conversation you have with non-Christians.

1: Hearing Conversations

1. Remember to Listen!

Practice "Active Listening" by asking probing questions: "What you're saying is..."
"... Is this accurate?"

2. Learn their Story!

"Tell me your story..."
"Describe to me your spiritual journey..."

- 3. Learn to Hear the "Sour Notes" (contradictory beliefs):
 - Belief vs. Heart-Longing
 - Belief vs. Behavior
 - Belief vs. Belief
 - Illogical Beliefs

Focus on the most significant sour note(s) only!

2: Illuminating Conversations

- 1. Ask Clarifying Questions: "What do you mean by...?"
- Ask questions to help people discover discrepancies in their beliefs for themselves.
- 3. Practice the 3D's

Learn to ask questions that:

- Surface Doubt
- Minimize **D**efensiveness
- Create a **D**esire to hear more

Example Questions:

"What is the meaning of life?"
"Are all religions the same?"
"What is your view on...?"

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3: Uncovering Conversations

- Determine if their issue is a real concern or a smoke screen: "If I could answer your question, would that help?"
- 2. What is the Nature of the Barrier:

Emotional, Intellectual, or both?

- 3. Uncover Emotional Baggage
- 4. Determine Hidden Concerns:
 - -They think Christians are arrogant.
 - -They are worried what their friends or family will think.
- 5. Motivate Them to Seek Answers
- 6. Find the Biggest Barrier
- 7. Uncover Volitional Factors: Pray for spiritual enlightenment and demonstrate Christ's love.

4: Building Conversations

- 1. Find Common Ground:
 - -Interests/hobbies
 - -Professional connection
 - -Religious beliefs
- 2. Build Bridges:

Build Heart Bridges Build Head Bridges

- 3. Remember the Goal:
 - -Remove obstacle to faith and help take one step closer to Christ.
- 4. Transition to the Gospel:
 - -Pre-Evangelism leads to Evangelism

Example Question:

"Has anyone ever explained the difference between Christianity and other religions?"

Conversational Pre-Evangelism in a Nutshell

We want to <u>listen</u> to our non-Christian friends, learn their stories and <u>hear</u> the discrepancies in their beliefs. We can then help them <u>illuminate</u> these discrepancies by asking questions that will <u>clarify</u> their belief system and <u>expose</u> the inconsistencies and contradictions in their perspective. We want to then <u>uncover the real barriers</u> that keep them from Christ and help them <u>build</u> <u>a bridge</u> to take one step closer to Jesus Christ each day.

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
