The headlines of September seemed extra heavy - hurricanes, floods, fires, earthquakes and terror attacks. But let these heavy images be a catalyst. A reminder of the urgency with which we have been commissioned to share the hope of Christ - be that in South End through a new Sunday evening. service targeting young adults, in Texas mucking out flooded homes or in Florida serving meals to thousands displaced. It also gives us urgency to find our place of service at Carmel as well as finding our place of community in a Discipleship Community with fellow believers. Have you stepped into those 'sacred places' of service and community?

Not only does this give us a sense of urgency for current daysbut it also reminds us of the faithfulness and sovereignty of our Savior for now and forevermore. The minor prophets from our Root 66 series have reminded us of this truth over and over again the last several weeks. We will wrap up the minor prophets later this month, take a 5-week detour, and then transition to the New Testament.

If you remember I gave you an acronym when we started this journey through the scriptures called A.M.P.E.C. to give a simple overview of the story. "A" stands for 'anticipation' to illustrate that, from Gienesis to Malachi, all of creation longed for and anticipated a Savior to bring salvation to mankind. We have watched the goodness and faithfulness of Good for the entirety of the Old Testament. Be encouraged Carmel. As the was faithful then, He is faithful today, and He will be faithful tomorrow. He is with you every step of your life and you are never alone or forgotten.

Disciple Maker Headed to Thailand

Alyssa Miller has called Carmel home for almost 5 years, but last month she left Carmel to head to Thailand.

My Story

I grew up in the church, however it wasn't until May of 2013, when I moved to Charlotte and joined a discipleship community that I was challenged to look at my relationship with Christ and make my faith my own. God led me to begin a weekly Bible study and then called me to use my passions of sports and kids to glorify Himself. He provided an opportunity through a Carmel mission trip to Ukraine in 2015 to help at a sports camp for kids. I returned from Ukraine



forever changed. God was working in my heart to put a fire in me to reach those who had not yet heard of the love of our Savior, Jesus. It was encouraging to be attending a Church that is so passionate about missions as can be seen through our "nearest, neighbors, and nations" mission statement. July 2016, I went to Ethiopia with Sports Friends for two weeks to help with their sports camps. While there, God clearly revealed to me my future, telling me, "this is what you were created to do." God prepared me to move to Thailand to put into practice the mission the placed in my heart.

Ministry through Sports + Chruch Planting

I have moved to Thailand to serve with Charlotte-based SIM, specifically in their Sports Friends (a ministry of SIM). Sports Friends stimulates a vision for local churches to use sports as a platform for reaching youth with the gospel. Sports provide a natural environment for discussing character issues and life lessons like self-control, honesty, teamwork, etc. These conversations often transition to the truths of the Bible. Sports Friends comes alongside local churches to train Christian leaders to coach, live, lead, and minister for the glory of Glod. Once each leader completes training, they go into communities to form youth sports teams. The relationship between a player and coach is powerful and transformative. It is through this relationship that a coach can demonstrate Glod's love and impact the lives of youth for eternity. There is currently no formal girls sport ministry in Bangkok so I have the opportunity to help create and lead this program, and then connect participants to the local church.
