Did you know?

Carmel seeks to provide a safe and secure campus with measures that include:

- An **Emergency Action Plan** (EAP): Regularly reviewed and rehearsed by leadership, our EAP includes responses for fire, tornadoes, facility lock downs, bomb threats, and more.
- School Day On-Campus Security: Three security guards monitor campus and facilitate a visitor check-in system that includes an immediate background check.
- Sunday **Security Team**: Two security officers, along with our Safety & Security group, monitor the campus on Sunday mornings.
- **Video Surveillance**: Interior and exterior cameras record activity throughout our campus. These are proactively monitored during the school day and on Sundays.
- A Child Protection Policy (CPP): Background checks are required and completed for all volunteers who
 work with children under age 18. Our CPP also includes specific steps to ensure the safety of children
 on campus.
- Evening Security Guests are directed to enter through the staffed, main entrance.
